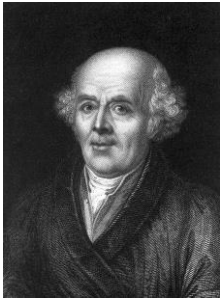

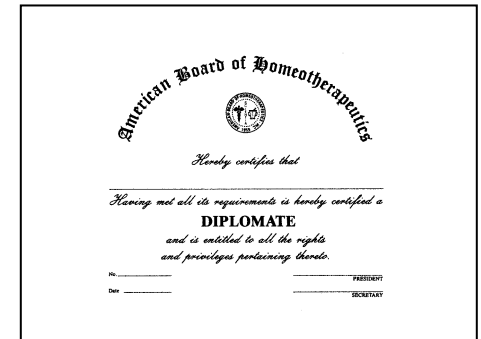

Diplomate Category Prerequisites

- Eligible for Active Membership in the American Institute of Homeopathy, the oldest extant national medical professional association in the USA (1844)
- Holds an MD or DO degree with a valid license to practice medicine in the resident state or province of practice in the United States or Canada (copy of dated license to accompany application)
- Minimum of 3 years of homeopathic practice
- Minimum of 350 hours of approved homeopathic education credits
- Unquestioned moral and professional standards confirmed by two American Board of Homeotherapeutics members
- Submit 10 double-spaced typed chronic treated cases, two months in advance of the exam
- Each case must have been treated for a minimum of 12 months; preferably for a minimum of 36 months for at least 5 of the 10 cases
